A.If you want to wait in the library, you must keep quiet.

A.As soon as the thief saw the police coming, he ran away.

21. Karthika reached the station. The train started. (scarcely ... when)

A.Scarcely had Karthika reached the station when the train started./Karthika had scarcely reached the station when the train started.

22. A musician may be great. He has to practise hard. (though)

A.Though a musician may be great, he has to practise hard.

23. One should not waste water. It is precious. (for)

A.One should not waste water for it is precious.
